**1. Read, read, read to your child.** I like this quote by Emilie Buchwald: "Children are made readers on the laps of their parents."

**2. Take your children to the library to check out books.** The Santa Maria Public Library and its Orcutt and Los Alamos branches are open most weekdays and on Saturday mornings, and they have all have a good selection of children's books. You may want to get a book or two or even a DVD for yourself, too.

**3. Ask your child to read to you.** For a child, there is nothing more magical than being able to read to his/her mom and dad. You will appreciate the moment, too.

**4. Take time to make sure your child has a book he/she is interested in.** Says Frank Serafini, "There is no such thing as a child who hates to read; there are only children who have not found the right book."

**5. Build your child's vocabulary.** Pick out interesting words and teach them to your child. You both can put the words to use in conversation.

**6. Encourage your child to re-read favorite books and poems.** Re-reading helps kids read more quickly and accurately.
