Principal's Message

We have a strong crop of future leaders on our campus. This past week, ASB students from OAK-8 and neighboring Olga Reed participated in a three-day Students Leading Education (SLED) Institute hosted by our district for junior high school and high school students. During the institute, our students learned about leadership, collaboration, and marketing from a group of facilitators from the nationally known iSchool Initiative.

The most important part of the institute involved students, teachers, and administrators (including me) in a discussion of problems they collectively face on our school sites. After hearing about a range of issues, the students were challenged to select a problem to solve, then develop a solution and action plan for addressing the problem.

OAK-8 and Olga Reed students were divided into three groups, and each group took on a very worthwhile issue. One group discussed how to bring OAK-8 and Olga Reed students closer together, a second group generated a plan for preparing students better for high school, and a third group thought of ways to incorporate more field trips into the curriculum. These groups presented their ideas with eloquence and passion, and we all were quite impressed.

The next step is to have our students present to the staffs of OAK-8 and Olga Reed. These students are future leaders and problem solvers, and I look forward to working with them to make our campus a better place.
